## GUIDING YOUR PREPARATION FOR PEEWEEES 2021

### CAMPER ARRIVAL

Check-in begins each morning at 9:00 a.m (Monday - Thursday). PeeWee Staff will be ready for your arrival at 8:45 a.m. Please do not arrive earlier than this unless you plan to stay with your camper until staff members are available. Upon your arrival please take your camper to the Rec Hall (building with names painted all over it) where your Pee Wee camper will be given a cubby hole for their items. Locate the Pee Wee Camp Director to pass on any camper medicine and/or any special instructions concerning your camper. Campers will play in the playground area until all Pee Wee campers arrive each morning.

### CAMPER PICK-UP

Camper pick-up is at 3:00 p.m. each afternoon (Monday - Thursday). Please make every effort to be here on time or even a few minutes early for camper pick-up. Campers will be checked out each day to ensure that they are being picked up by the appropriate person. Campers will be picked up in the same Rec Hall/ Playground area where they are dropped off each morning.

### WHAT TO SEND WITH MY CHILD TO PEE WEES

**Clothing:** T-shirt, shorts, and tennis shoes (no sandals or crocs please)

**Lunch:** Bring a sack lunch each day except Thursday. Lunches are not refrigerated. Drinks will be provided each day at camp. (Thursday the campers will go for a hot dog cookout.)

**Swimming:** Bring a swimsuit, towel, and sunscreen if needed. Lifeguards are on duty during all swimtimes.

**Puddle Jumper lifejackets are available for campers who are still learning to swim.**

- All 5 & 6 year old Pee Wee campers must wear a puddle jumper during swimtime.
- All 7 & 8 year old Pee Wee campers must pass a simple swim test in order to swim without a Puddle Jumper lifejacket. The swim test is simple...campers must be able to swim the length of the pool without aid.

### DAILY ACTIVITIES

Each day Pee Wee campers will participate in a number of activities.

**Swimming:** PeeWees LOVE swim time. Every day PeeWees get to swim for about 30 minutes. Don't forget to pack a swimsuit!

**Crafts:** Every day, our PeeWees get crafty with a guided arts and crafts project. At the end of the week they'll get to bring home all of their crafty masterpieces!

**Bible Lesson:** Our staff lead daily bible lessons with our PeeWees that are fun and easy to grasp, but also impactful and formative to your camper's faith!

**Hymn Time:** At hymn time we spend 30 minutes praising God in song - fun songs!

**Group Games:** This is the time of day that we do our theme day activities. Check out the next page for more info on our theme days!

**Snack:** All that fun can really work up an appetite. We provide a snack for our PeeWees every afternoon.

**Horseback Riding:** At least once a week each PeeWee camper will have the opportunity to go on a short halter-led horseback ride. PeeWee horseback riding is an awesome introduction to horses!

## THEME DAYS

### MONDAY: GOOFY GAME DAY

Campers enjoy playing all kinds of simple goofy games together during their first day of camp, like sack races and other "minute to win it" type games! **What your camper could wear:** There's no need to dress up special for the first day, but if you want to get in the competitive spirit, sports jerseys or t-shirts are a fun option!

### TUESDAY: WILD WATER DAY

Campers always have fun splashing in Killi Creek! Please send an extra shirt for your camper to wear over their swimsuit in the creek. **What your camper could wear:** For wild water day a swimsuit is vital. Water shoes are also great for wearing in the creek. Don't forget a towel too!

### WEDNESDAY: CRAZY COLOR DAY

Campers will enjoy some simple yet color-filled activities throughout the day, ending with an appearance from the "Color Blob," a counselor painted head to toe in crazy colors! There's so better way to get the Color Blob cleaned off than a water balloon fight, so pack some extra dry clothes just in case! **What your camper could wear:** Crazy Colors! Any colorful outfit is perfect for this day. Campers could also get decked out in clothes that are all one color!

Campers will enjoy a traditional cookout with silly songs, campfire stories and hot dogs cooked over a campfire for lunch. You do not need to send a lunch with your camper on this day. **What your camper could wear:** Regular activewear is great for cookout day.
